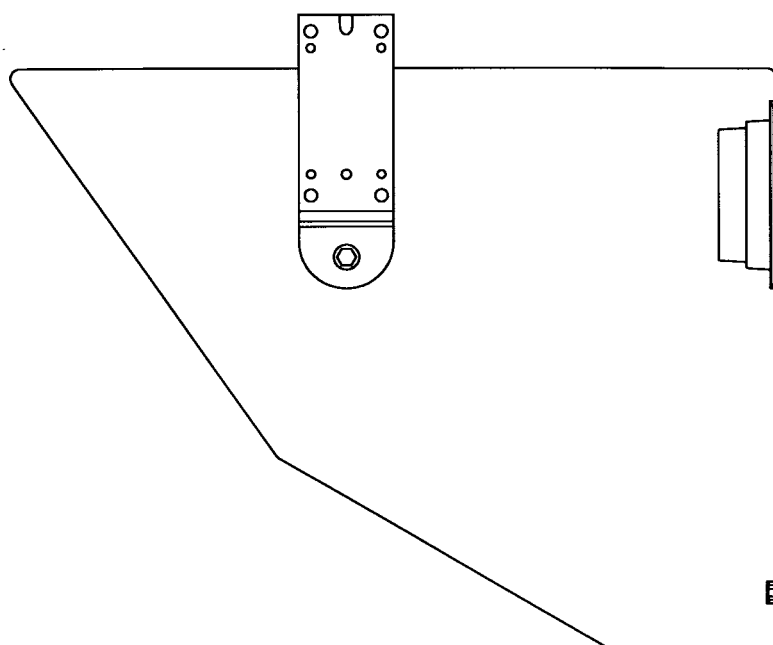


MB-VI15

Mounting Bracket Kit

- Mounting kit for VI-15 speakers
- May be used in conjunction with OmniMount® Series 100 support system¹
- Allows suspension of VI-15 speakers from the ceiling



Description

The MB-VI15 mounting bracket kit consists of a 10-gauge, cold-rolled-steel U-bracket, two friction pads and two washers. The kit is specifically designed for ceiling mounting of the VI-15 speaker system. The MB-VI15 mounting bracket kit may be used in conjunction with the OmniMount® Series 100 support system.¹

The MB-VI15 allows each system to rotate around its enclosure mounting centers, permitting angular adjustment after mounting. The MB-VI15 allows the VI-15 speaker to be mounted in almost any position so as to obtain the desired sound coverage.

Mounting Location Selection and Preparation

The MB-VI15 U-brackets should be attached to the mounting surface before the system is secured to the brackets. The fasteners required to affix the bracket to the mounting surface will need to be selected by the user to fit the particular installation.

Mounting Instructions

Refer to Figure 1 for the following steps.

1. Remove the paper backing from one of the friction pads (4) and attach to the U-bracket (1) as shown. Be sure the two holes are aligned. Attach the second friction pad in a similar manner.
2. Attach the U-bracket to the wall or ceiling using fasteners (not supplied) that are suitable for the construction material.
3. Using the 3/8-inch bolts mounted to the VI-15, assemble as shown in Figure 1. Attach a pull-up strap (not supplied) to the 3/8-16 T-nut located on the lower back of the enclosure using either the 3/8-16 shoulder bolt supplied with the system or a structurally rated 3/8-16 forged shoulder eyebolt (not supplied).

4. Position the speaker for desired coverage, changing the angle by adjusting the length of the pull-up strap. The maximum rotation from horizontal that may be reached is approximately 25° (see Figure 2). Tighten the screws sufficiently so that the speaker does not inadvertently rotate.

CAUTION:

Due to the weight of the VI-15 enclosure, it is imperative that the MB-VI15 bracket be properly secured to the wall or ceiling. The choice of fastener (not provided with bracket kit) will be determined by the material and construction of the mounting surface.

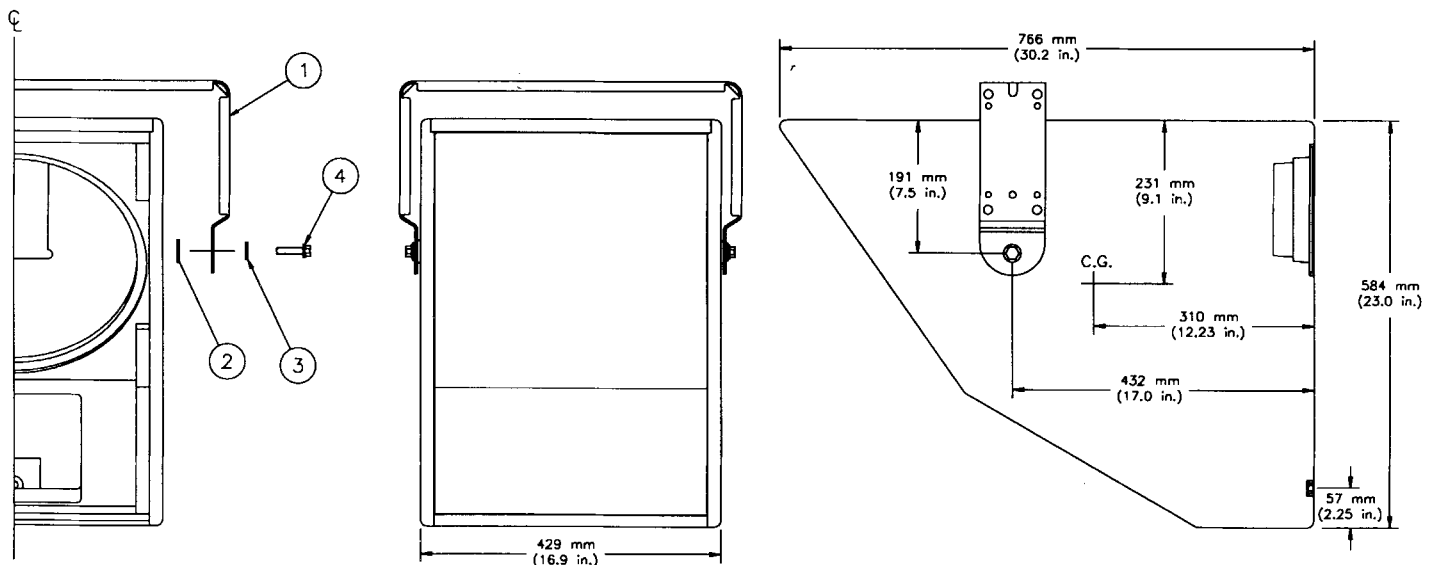

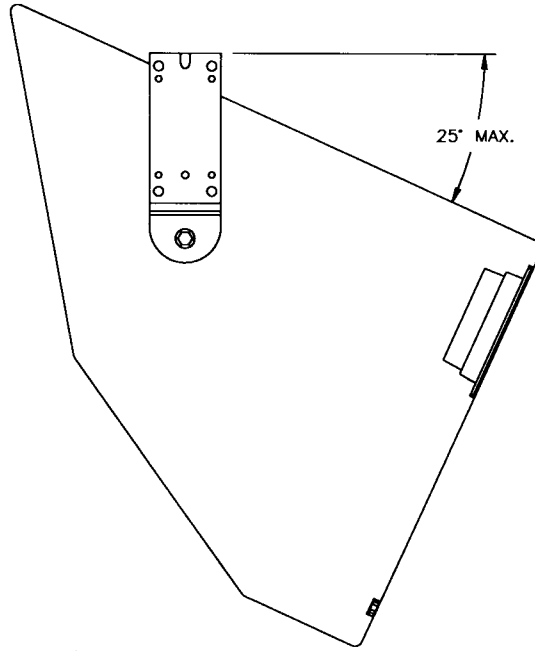

Figure 1—MB-VI15 Mounting Bracket



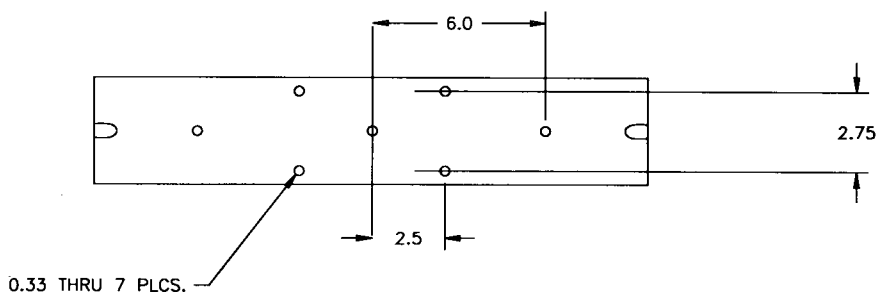
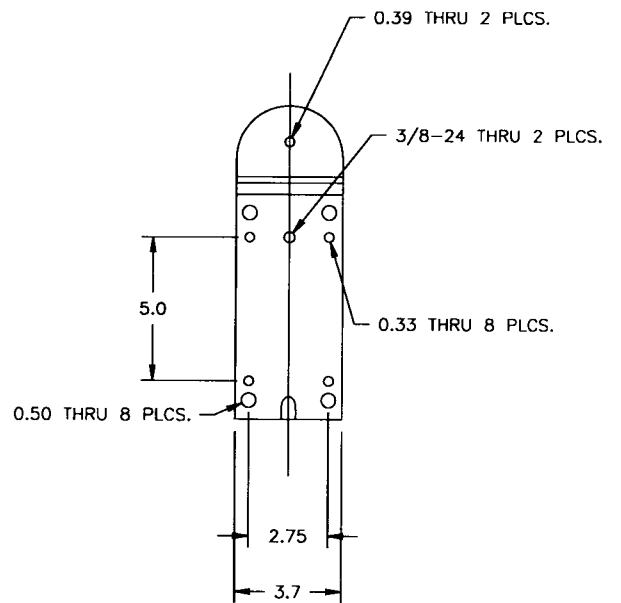
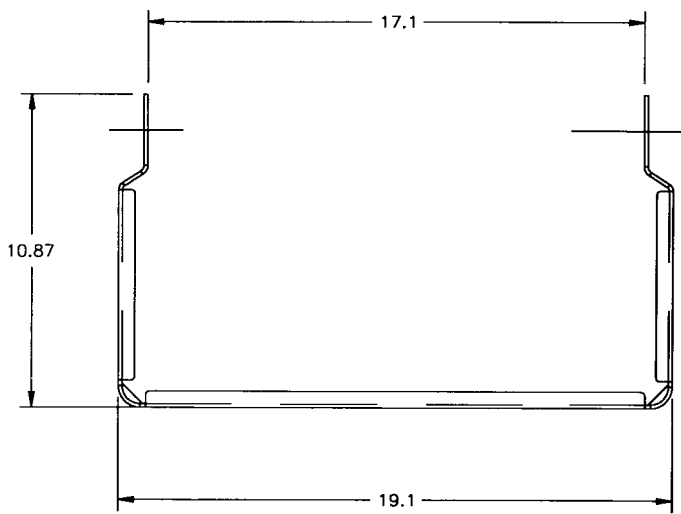
