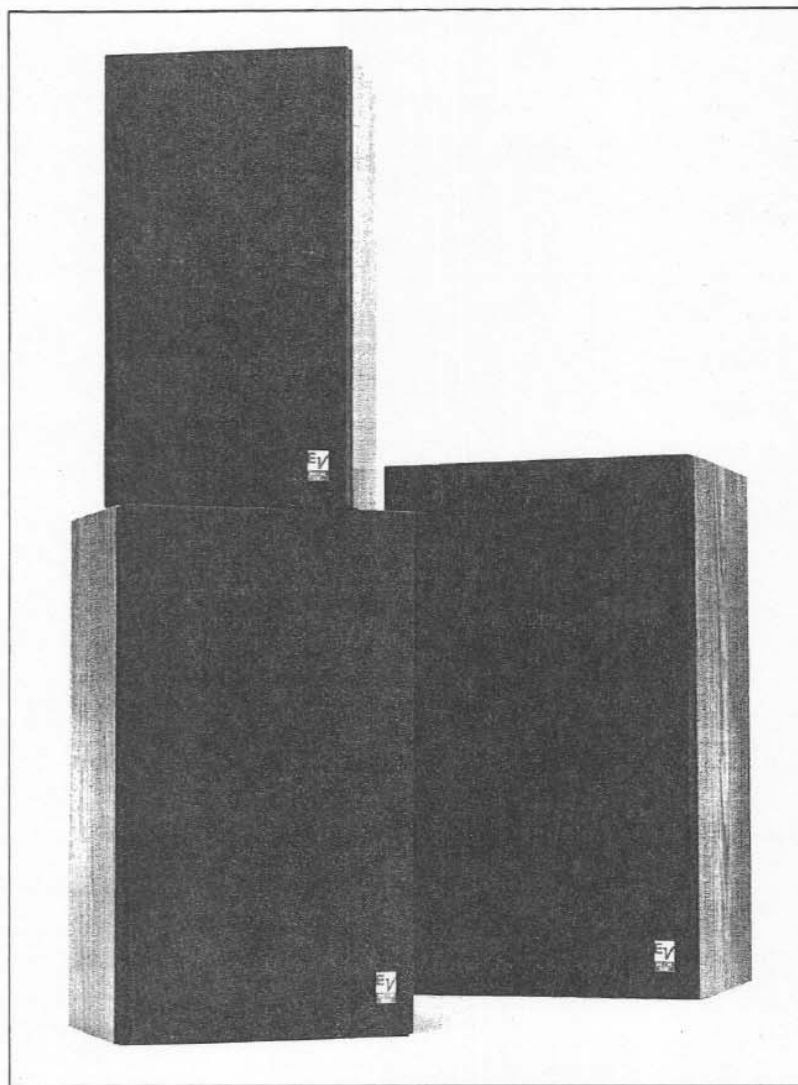

Encore

The Encore loudspeaker line represents an extraordinary development in loudspeaker design. These speakers combine the low-frequency performance associated with acoustic suspension (sealed-box) speakers with efficiency that approaches that found in vented-enclosure designs. And, you get this performance at a price you can afford.

Encore speakers, because of their efficiency, can be used with amplifiers or receivers with modest power output – without sacrificing your ability to listen to music at levels approaching “live concert” volume. Plus, all Encore speakers are capable of handling the output of up to 150-watt amplifiers.

Attractive styling makes Encore speakers a handsome addition to any decor. All speakers may be placed either horizontally or vertically without compromising dispersion. The optional BBR-1 speaker stands allow any Encore speaker to be placed on the floor if your listening environment precludes their being used as bookshelf speakers.

All in all, Encore speakers represent a superb value for the value-conscious music lover. Whether you’re buying Encore speakers as an addition to your existing system or for your first hi-fi system, you won’t be disappointed.

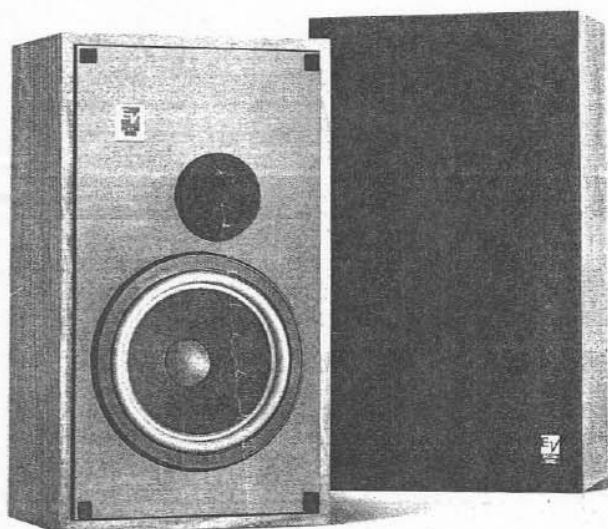

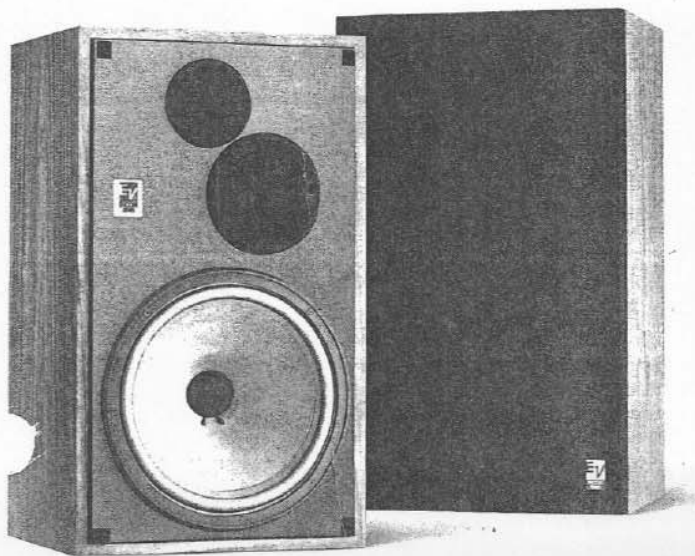
The Encore 33 is an extraordinary speaker for the cost-conscious music lover. Its frequency response allows you to enjoy all but the deepest bass from your recorded material. The small size and attractive styling of the 33 allow it to be placed almost anywhere without fear of it detracting from the room appearance.

Whether you're buying the 33's for your first system or as an additional pair of speakers for your existing system, you will be investing in a quality high-fidelity component. Encore 33's—excellent value for the buyer on a budget.



With the Encore 55 you will get 10 Hz more bass from a speaker that is 3 dB more efficient than the 33. The additional 10 Hz in low-end frequency response will allow you to listen to virtually all recorded material, and be able to hear everything that's there. The additional 3 dB in efficiency should be particularly attractive to the individual who plans on purchasing more than a receiver and turntable. That extra 3 dB means that you will only need *half* the amplifier power to achieve the same volume level as you would with the Encore 33. That extra money you'll save on your amplifier or receiver can go towards a state-of-the-art phono cartridge, a pair of headphones, a tape deck and the like.

Not only is the Encore 55 an exceptional value in its own right, but offers you the option of expanding your system with equipment you might not have thought you could afford.



The Encore 77 will make your stereo system sound like it is supposed to. The 30 Hz low-end will reproduce those bass pedal organ notes or the impact of a closely-miked kick drum with superb clarity. The 77 also is as efficient as the Encore 55 allowing you to save money on your amplifier purchase, or by using a larger amplifier, to enjoy sound pressure levels approaching those found at a live concert. With the Encore 77 you'll be getting the accuracy and efficiency normally found in speakers costing much, much more.

The Encore 77, although a true bookshelf system, may be slightly large for the smaller apartment or listening room shelf. The optional BBR-1 speaker stands will make excellent additions to your system, for they will allow you to place your 77's on the floor without impairing the frequency response. This setup will turn your 77's into pieces of exceptionally good looking furniture.

If you're looking for top-of-the-line speakers at less than top-of-the-line prices, Encore 77's are the speakers you should buy.
